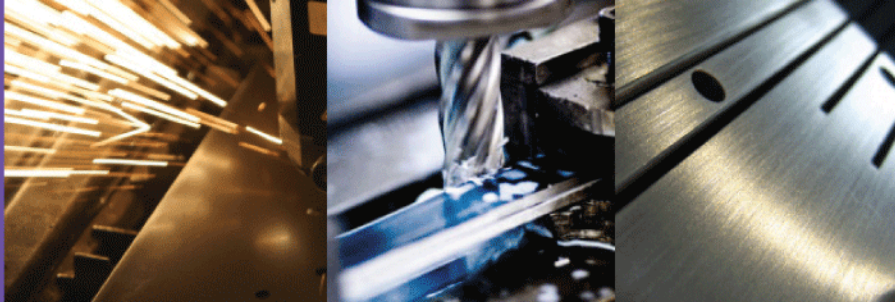

METKLEEN 2200 is a liquid, acidic cleaner to deoxidize, descale and de-rust metals. **METKLEEN 2200** will passivate and pickle metal surfaces to improve paint or plating adhesion. **METKLEEN 2200** can be used in “rework operations” to simultaneously clean and de-rust parts. **METKLEEN 2200** is NSF Approved A1 Food Grade. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

METKLEEN 2200 is typically diluted in water between 10% and 50%. The proper mixing ration is dependent on cleaning temperature, exposure time, composition of soil and application method. **METKLEEN 2200** is formulated to clean between 60° and 150° F and can be applied by dip, tank or spray methods.

PACKAGING

METKLEEN 2200 is available in 5-gallon pails, 55-gallon drums, 330-gallon totes and bulk.
