PRE-TESTING is recommended prior to use on painted surfaces. METKLEEN 2310 cannot be used on aluminum surfaces**

**\*NOTE:** This product is approved by NSF International and is acceptable for use as a general cleaner (A1) on all surfaces in and around food processing areas, where its use is not intended for direct food contact. NSF Registration #152087.
